Approximately 75-80 plus were in attendance. General feedback was very positive.</p> <p>The committee finalized all invoices and receipts (attached) for the final report. A wrap up meeting was held June 24 at Soror Gray's home. Based on a review of the conference evaluations, budget allocations and rigorous committee discussion, the committee recommendation was to proceed with the Empowerment Conference for the 2019-2020 sorority year and to garner feedback and support from chapter members on the best way to proceed. Several options and a chapter survey were developed.
